Without doubt the bible has been the most influential body of writing in human history, and yet it is hard to read and understand. The fragments we usually read in church don't always give a sense of the whole book. In a sermon series this spring we will be taking a birds eye view, seeing the big picture and making the connections, so that we can read it not as a series of disconnected fragments but as the story of everything, with a beginning a middle and an end.
